

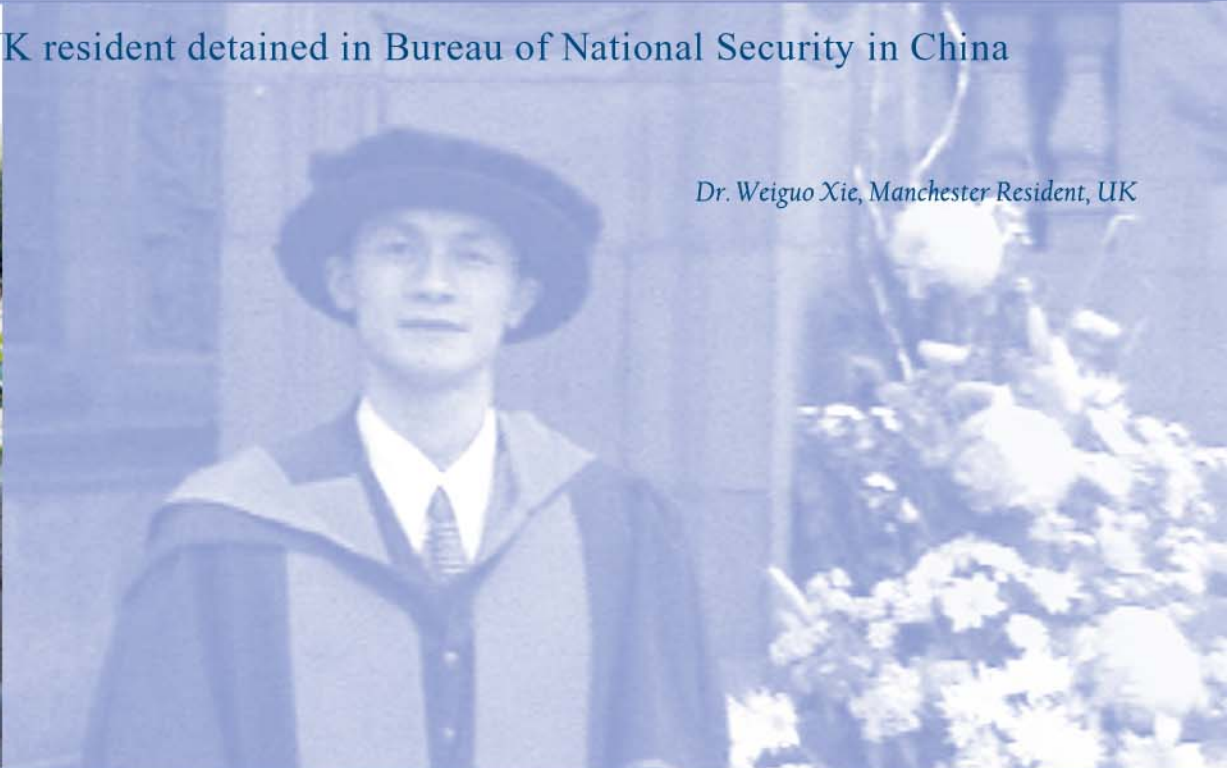

## my fiancée Yongjie Zhu

Fiancée of UK resident detained in Bureau of National Security in China

My fiancée, Yongjie Zhu, is 29 years old. She lives in Beijing, China. She is a staff of Tsinghua Tongfang Group Company. She was arrested by Bureau of National Security in China on 4th November 2002 in Beijing. Since then, her whereabouts was not known.

Yongjie started practising Falun Gong in 1995. She became a more helpful person at home and at work. But, in July 20th 1999, the Chinese Government banned Falun Gong and began a campaign of brutal persecution against Falun Gong. Yongjie was forced to leave home and wander about since 29th October 2002 in Beijing because of the pressure from police before 16th Congress of Community Party in China. She also lost her job.

When Yongjie was arrested, her parents had been interrogated by a member of Bureau of National Security in China. This member tried to find out more information of mine in UK. I, also a Falun Gong practitioner, has been already put into blacklist in Bureau of National Security in China because I adhere to practising Falun Gong outside China.

Falun Gong, also known as Falun Dafa, is an ancient and advanced system for improving body, mind and spirit. It involves the practice of gentle, meditative exercises and the improvement of one's spiritual awareness according to the principles of Truthfulness, Compassion, and Tolerance. Yongjie is only one of the thousands of unlawfully detained Falun Gong practitioners in China. As far as we knew hundreds of practitioners have been abused in mental hospitals, and sentenced to up to 18 years imprisonment, tortured. I do hope that the British Government and people can help to free my fiancée and all imprisoned Falun Gong practitioners in China.
